POKER RUN INFORMATION

- **DEFINITION:** A ***Poker Run*** is an organized event using a form of transportation where participants travel over a pre-designated route and, at designated stops on the route, draw playing card(s).
- **OBJECT:** The object is to have the best poker hand at the end of the run, not the best time. So take your time and enjoy the run. (Poker hands explained in entry packet)
- **COURSE:** Driving directions will be given to each participant at the Starting point.
- **FEE:** There is a \$20.00 entry which includes the price of one hand. All additional hands are \$10.00 each and participants may play as many hands as desired.
- **PRIZES:** 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prizes are awarded for the best hand. First 15 cars to pre register will win a KSCC cooler bag. Other prizes will be awarded the day of the event.
- **NOTE:** Each participant will be responsible to maintain the integrity of their cards during the Run.



Official Rules & Information

1. Course directions will be distributed at "Starting" point
2. All Stops will be identified and manned by two Run Officials.
3. Participants will run a prescribed course, making 4 stops and drawing one (1) card at each "Stop". One card will also be drawn by each participant at the starting point for a total of 5 cards per hand.
4. Each card picked will be recorded on the participants scoring sheet by a Run Official at the Stop.
5. NO duplicate cards can be used. Participants must draw an additional card if an identical card is drawn. (Example: If an Ace of Spades is picked at the 2nd Stop & an Ace of Spades is picked at the 4th Stop, the participant must pick another card at the 4th Stop).
6. Participants can play more than one hand, the participant must present the appropriate Poker Hand Talley Sheet to be marked BEFORE each card is drawn.
7. An option would include an opportunity to lay down one card at course mid-point by answering a surprise question correctly. (Card to be dropped must be identified BEFORE a new card is drawn). Talley Sheet is updated by Run Official.
8. An option would include an opportunity to lay down two cards and purchase two new cards for \$5.00 each at course completion. (Card to be dropped must be identified BEFORE a new card is drawn. Talley Sheet is updated by Run Official.
9. Latest possible return time to last Stop: 3:00 p.m.
10. 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prizes will be awarded.
11. All decisions by the Judges are FINAL!
